The Tanganyika Law Society has been approached by the International Criminal Court (ICC) to host a brief information event on **Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2010 from 1400hrs to 1600hrs at the Sea Cliff Hotel to promote the ICC campaign, “Calling African Female Lawyers”**.

Please be informed that on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2010, the ICC and the International Bar Association (IBA) jointly launched a major information campaign to **increase the number of female counsel practicing at the ICC**. The initial focus is on African countries, but the ICC and IBA will look at the possibility of expanding the campaign to other regions of the world at a later point. During the six month campaign, comprehensive information packages will be distributed in a number of African countries, mainly through the national bar associations.
