SEMINAR ON PRACTICAL ADVOCACY SKILLS

The Tanganyika Law Society (TLS) and the United Kingdom's Solicitors' Association of Higher Court Advocates (SAHCA) have organized a **three-day**, CLE seminar on **"Practical Advocacy Skills for Practicing Lawyers"**. Seminar materials will be provided to participants at the venue; a summarized course outline will be made available to members via e-mail with a future seminar reminder.

The seminar will be held at the **Blue Pearl Hotel (Ubungo Plaza)**, Dar es Salaam from **Wednesday 21st September through to Friday 23rd September, 2011** from **0900HRS to 1600HRS on each day**.
